### DAY 1: ARRIVE MONTREAL

Upon arrival in Montreal, meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel for a two-night stay at the historic Fairmont The Queen Elizabeth Hotel. Montreal hosted the 1976 Summer Olympics, and played host to Expo 67, considered to be the most successful world's fair of the 20th Century.

## DAY 2: MONTREAL CITY TOUR

With its dual English and French cultures, Montreal is Canada's most cosmopolitan city and a city comes alive during the holiday season. Today enjoy a Montreal City Tour highlighting the Notre Dame Cathedral, St. Joseph's Oratory, Jacques Cartier Square, McGill University and a panoramic view of the city from atop Mount Royal. Stop to visit the Underground City (the RÉSO), one of Montreal's biggest visitor attractions which keeps Montrealers warm during the winter months. The RÉSO features shops and restaurants, and is connected to subways, train stations & hotels. Free time this afternoon to explore a Christmas Market or enjoy Montreal on your own. This evening enjoy a Welcome Dinner with your fellow travelers at a local restaurant in Old Town Montreal. The Old City features 17th and 18th century architecture, cafes, restaurants & cobblestone streets all contributing to a quaint European-like charm. The festive spirit of the holiday season is found in Old Town and throughout the city during your time in Montreal.

DAY 3: MONTREAL - RAIL JOURNEY - QUEBEC CITY This morning board Via Rail Canada for the scenic and relaxing train ride to the "Paris of North America," Quebec City. Carved into the bluffs overlooking the St. Lawrence River, Quebec City is the provincial capital and probably the best preserved city in North America. Upon arrival, check into the famous Fairmont Chateau Frontenac Hotel for a three-night stay. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore one of the oldest cities in Canada. Quebec City, a UNESCO World Heritage site, has among its distinguishing characteristics narrow cobblestone streets, stone buildings, fortifications and a French Canadian culture. It has a distinct old-world character and charm including festive holiday decorations and lighting.

### DAY 4: QUEBEC CITY SIGHTSEEING

Today enjoy a Quebec City Tour introducing you to Old & New Quebec, North America's only walled city. The tour features the Plains of Abraham, The Citadel and St. Lawrence River views. Later visit the St. Anne de Beaupre Shrine, located on the shores of the St. Lawrence River. For over 350 years, people of all ages have been gathering at this Shrine dedicated to Saint Anne, the grandmother of Jesus. Through the beauty of numerous artistic masterpieces discover the extraordinary history of Saint Anne. Also visit Albert Gilles Copper Museum. From copper ore to copper art, discover the mysterious atmosphere of a copper mine. See the copper bearing rocks and then admire the fine artifacts collected from around the world. Then visit the scenic Montmorency Falls, the highest falls in Eastern Canada–98 feet higher than Niagara



Falls & one of the most popular attractions in the region. Later return to Quebec City and enjoy the evening at leisure.

# DAY 5: OLD QUEBEC - LEISURE TIME

This morning enjoy a Sugar Shack Demonstration and experience a celebration of all things maple, which is one of Quebec's biggest exports. This afternoon enjoy a visit & leisure time to explore the German inspired Old Québec Christmas Market, a market designed to recreate the atmosphere of the big European Christmas Markets. Lights, decorations, and snow create an enchanting setting like no other within Old Quebec. No wonder CNN ranked Québec City among the world's top 15 destinations for celebrating the Holidays! This evening enjoy a Farewell Dinner with your fellow travelers at local restaurant with holiday flair.

# 2024 CHRISTMAS MARKETS TERMS AND CONDITIONS - TRAVELCENTER, INC DBA BOSCOV'S TRAVEL AND PREMIER WORLD DISCOVERY

This agreement sets forth the terms and conditions under which we, Travelcenter, Inc DBA Boscov's Travel and Premier World Discovery in return for payment of the amount indicated as the total price, agree to provide this tour.

Deposit & Final Payment: A deposit of \$500 per person and a signed contract are required to secure reservations. Final payment is September 5, 2024.

Roundtrip Motorcoach Transportation: Roundtrip motorcoach transportation to your departure airport is included.

Air Transportation: Roundtrip air transportation to Montreal and from Quebec City, Canada (including current air taxes, government fees and current fuel surcharges - air rates are ESTIMATED based on projected 2024 rates and are subject to change once December 2024 rates are confirmed.)

Name Changes are not allowed. Each passenger cancellation is processed independently of any new passenger booking.

Passport & Date of Birth Information: A valid passport book (not a passport card) is required and is the responsibility of each passenger. Passports should be valid for up to six (6) months beyond the travel dates. All names must be submitted exactly as they appear on passenger passports. Dates of Birth (DOB's) are required. Copies of passports are required. Additional forms maybe necessary based on the destination.

### **Cancellation Policy & Fees:**

Cancel more than 180 days prior to departure - Full Refund of Deposit

Cancel 179-75 days prior to departure: Deposit is Retained

Cancel 74-60 days prior to departure: 25% of total price

Cancel 59-30 days prior to departure: 50% of total price

Cancel 29-15 days prior to departure: 75% of total price

Cancel 14 days or less prior to departure/no shows: No refunds

Once ticketed, air becomes non-refundable. There is no refund for no-shows. The specified amount will be subtracted from all/any deposits or payments in our possession. No refund allowed for any arrangements, features or services included in the travel program, which are not used at the discretion of the client.

Name mistakes or corrections are subject to change fees per the airlines.

#### **GENERAL LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS**

Unless otherwise shown below, these exclusions apply to the Insured, the Insured's Traveling Companion, or Family Member scheduled and booked to travel with the Insured.

### The following exclusion applies to the Trip Cancellation and Trip Interruption and Medical Expense:

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from a Pre-Existing Medical Condition, as defined in the plan.

### The following exclusions apply to the Medical Expense benefits.

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from:

- 1. routine physical examinations or routine dental care;
- 2. traveling for the purpose or intent of securing medical treatment or advice;
- 3. Alcohol or substance abuse or treatment for the same;
- 4. Normal pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or childbirth, or elective abortion;
- 5. a Mental, Nervous or Psychological Condition or Disorder unless Hospitalized or Partially Hospitalized while the plan is in effect;
- 6. the Insured's participation in Adventure or Extreme Activities, riding or driving in races, or participation in speed or endurance competition or events, except as a spectator;
- 7. the Insured's participation in an organized athletic or sporting competition, contest, or stunt under contract in exchange for an agreed-upon salary or compensation. This does not include athletes participating in exchange for a scholarship or tuition.

The plan also contains exclusions specific to Baggage & Personal Effects and Baggage Delay.

### In addition to any applicable benefit-specific exclusion, the following general exclusions apply to all losses and all benefits.

We will not pay for any loss or expense caused due to, arising or resulting from:

- 1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of the Insured, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner booked and scheduled to travel with the Insured, while sane or insane;
- 2. being under the influence of drugs or narcotics, unless administered upon the advice of a Physician as prescribed;
- 3. activities, losses, or claims involving or resulting from possession, production, processing, sale, or use of marijuana, illegal drugs, alcohol or substances are excluded from coverage;
- 4. war or act of war, including invasion, acts of foreign enemies, hostilities between nations (whether declared or undeclared), or civil war;
- 5. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation by the Insured, a Traveling Companion, Family Member, or Business Partner;
- 6. directly or indirectly, the actual, alleged or threatened use, discharge, dispersal, seepage, migration, escape, release or exposure to any hazardous biological, chemical, nuclear radioactive weapon, device, material, gas, matter or contamination;
- 7. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft.

### **Pre-Existing Medical Condition Exclusion Waiver**

The Pre-Existing Condition Exclusion will be waived if the protection plan is purchased within 14 days of the date the initial trip payment/deposit is received, and you are medically able and not disabled from travel at the time you pay for the plan, based on assessment of a physician.
