Bob Wilson promoted to managing director of new Maryland Public Television unit

OWINGS MILLS, MD – Bob Wilson, for the past 16 years an executive producer of interactive media at Maryland Public Television (MPT), has been named managing director of a new MPT unit, Digital Content & Operations. In his new post, Wilson oversees the principal digital operations and content assets of the statewide public TV network.

He is responsible for MPT's website, streaming services, and social media operations among other duties. He has managed several website redesigns and was the project lead for the launch of the network's online video player, which streams MPT's own productions in addition to prime programming from PBS.

Wilson joined MPT in 2005, becoming senior web director within the network's creative services unit. Earlier he had served in a number of managerial capacities for 15 years at the Wolf Trap Foundation for the Performing Arts in Virginia. Still earlier he was a museum interpreter for Decatur House, an historic house museum in Washington, D.C.



An alumnus of the College of William and Mary, Wilson earned his undergraduate degree in art history and holds a master's in business from Johns Hopkins University. He resides in Arlington, Virginia.
