**Maryland Public Television to produce and air
Ask the Governor: Examining Education on September 13
*Journalists are invited to watch taping from press room at MPT***

OWINGS MILLS, MD – [Maryland Public Television](http://MarylandPublicTelevision.org) (MPT) will produce [Ask the Governor: Examining Education](http://AskTheGovernor.org) with **Maryland Governor Wes Moore** in front of a live studio audience on Wednesday, September 13.

The one-hour townhall-style production, hosted by MPT news anchor Jeff Salkin, will feature Gov. Moore addressing topics related to education in the Free State and the major education reform known as the Blueprint for Maryland's Future. The governor will answer questions posed by Salkin and several members of the studio audience, along with recorded questions from parents and students from across the state.

Date/time: The program will be recorded live-to-tape (with no editing) starting at 3 p.m. on Wednesday, September 13.

Airtimes: The program will premiere that evening at 7 p.m. on MPT-HD and the [MPT live stream](http://MPTLive.org). It will re-air at 11 p.m. and will be available to stream on-demand on the free [PBS App](http://PBSApp.org) following the premiere.

- Audio recording is permissible only to ensure accurate reporting.
- Due to schedule demands, Gov. Moore will not be available to the press following the program taping.
