OWINGS MILLS, MD – [Maryland Public Television](http://MarylandPublicTelevision.org) (MPT) will air a one-hour block of programming on Thursday, February 15 to acquaint viewers with David Rubenstein, the Baltimore-native businessman, philanthropist, and investor who is leading the group currently in the process of purchasing the Baltimore Orioles Major League Baseball franchise.

***In Person with David Rubenstein* – February 15, 7 p.m. (rebroadcast from 2021)**

Baltimore born and raised, David Rubenstein is an author, TV host, legendary businessman, and philanthropist. His rise from a student at Baltimore's City College to White House aide to billionaire global investor took patience, hard work, and a dash of good luck. In this 30-minute MPT special, viewers join Rubenstein and former Maryland Secretary of Commerce Michael Gill at the Maryland State House for a one-on-one discussion about Rubenstein's upbringing in Charm City, his search for the right career, and keys to his success.
